Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §655, sub-§1, ¶S, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 555, §1, is amended to read:

S. Mining property as provided in section 2854.; and

Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §655, sub-§1, ¶T is enacted to read:

T. Lobster traps as defined in Title 12, section 6001, subsection 24; cars as defined in Title 12, section 6001, subsection 5; and fishing nets.

SUMMARY

This bill exempts lobster traps and cars and fishing nets from the personal property tax.
