

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6535, sub-§6 is enacted to read:**

6 6. Temporary license. A 30-day temporary sea urchin and  
8 scallop diving tender license may be granted to a person who  
10 fulfills the requirements of this section and section 6748. The  
12 training required under chapter 621, subchapter II does not apply  
14 to such a license. The fee for a temporary sea urchin and  
16 scallop diving tender license is \$25.

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill creates a 30-day sea urchin and scallop diving  
16 tender license.
