Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6535, sub-§6 is enacted to read:

6. Temporary license. A 30-day temporary sea urchin and
6 scallop diving tender license may be granted to a person who
fulfills the requirements of this section and section 6748. The
8 training required under chapter 621, subchapter II does not apply
to such a license. The fee for a temporary sea urchin and
10 scallop diving tender license is \$25.

SUMMARY

This bill creates a 30-day sea urchin and scallop diving 16 tender license.
