COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 253, L.D. 317, Bill, "An Act Relating to the State Valuation of the Town of Corinna"

Amend the bill by inserting after the title the following:

'Mandate Preamble. This measure requires one or more local units of government to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues, but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures.

Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires Penobscot County to issue supplemental tax bills to the other municipalities in the county if tax bills using the certified state valuation previously determined have already been sent. The additional costs of this state mandate are minor. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.

The Office of the Treasurer of State will be required to recalculate and redistribute municipal revenue sharing. The redistribution will increase the amount provided to the Town of Corinna while slightly reducing the amounts to all other municipalities.

The revised valuation will have no net effect on the school subsidy received by the Town of Corinna and will not result in a redistribution of subsidies for other school administrative units.'
