

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §256, sub-§10** is enacted to read:

6 10. Rules regarding rabies vaccinations for animals brought
8 to school. The commissioner shall adopt routine technical rules
10 as defined by Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter II-A regarding
12 rabies vaccinations for animals brought on the premises of a
14 public school to ensure that animals have current and appropriate
16 rabies vaccinations.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill requires the Commissioner of Education to adopt
18 rules regarding requirements for rabies vaccinations for animals
20 that are brought on the premises of a public school.
