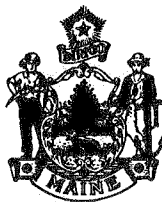

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15907, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:**

6 1-A. State's share limited. The State's share must be  
8 based on a cost per square foot, for all aspects of construction,  
10 not exceeding \$75. The State's share may be used only for  
12 facilities related to essential services. The commissioner may  
14 adopt rules to define essential services. These rules are major  
16 substantive rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter  
II-A.

### SUMMARY

This bill limits the State's reimbursement for public school construction and renovation projects.
