COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 257, L.D. 321, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Maine Workers' Compensation Act of 1992 as It Relates to Compensation for Total Incapacity"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2-A in the last line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or is not functional"

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 16 and 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or a functional"

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4 in the last line (page 1, line 24 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or is not functional"

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The state employees' workers' compensation program may incur some minor additional costs related to the lump-sum payment provisions. These costs are not expected to affect the amounts budgeted by state departments and agencies for workers' compensation.'

This amendment limits the benefits payable under the bill to amputations by eliminating the availability of benefits when there is functional loss of a body part.
