SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 263, L.D. 327, Bill, "An Act to Expand Access to Maine's Technical Colleges"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in the first paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 25 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$1,800,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$300,000' and in the 9th line (page 1, line 33 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$1,800,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$300,000' and in the last line (page 1, line 36 in amendment) by striking out the following: "500" and inserting in its place the following: 'approximately 85'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of the 8th line (page 1, line 49 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

All Other \$300,000'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in the last line (page 2, line 5 in amendment) by striking out the following: "500" and inserting in its place the following: 'approximately 85'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$1,500,000 in fiscal year 1998-99.
