Sec. 1. Study of unemployment compensation program. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Labor shall study the unemployment 2 compensation program to assess whether it is meeting the changing needs of the labor force and the business community. The 4 commissioner shall examine the seasonality exclusion, disqualification of persons who lose work because of problems 6 with child care or transportation, the timeliness of the extended 8 benefit trigger and the adequacy of benefit duration in the dislocated worker benefit program. The commissioner shall submit a report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature 10 having jurisdiction over labor matters and the Executive Director 12 of the Legislative Council by December 1, 1997.

SUMMARY

This resolve directs the Commissioner of Labor to study the unemployment compensation program to assess whether it is meeting the changing needs of the labor force and the business community. The commissioner is required to submit a report by December 1, 1997.
