

2 **Sec. 1. Report on poverty. Resolved:** That the State Planning
Office shall report annually to the Legislature, beginning on
4 January 1, 1998, on the subject of poverty in this State. The
report must include information on poverty among children and
6 adults, regional differences in poverty rates and indicators,
conditions responsible for changes from the prior year,
8 expectations for the coming year and the economic condition of
the State's communities.
