COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 274, L.D. 338, Bill, "An Act Regarding the Funding of Search and Rescues by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires a bill to be reported out by the joint standing committee having jurisdiction over inland fisheries and wildlife during each regular session to request General Fund money for the full cost of search and rescue. This bill will become effective for the Second Regular Session of the 118th Legislature. The estimated cost for funding the full cost of search and rescue is \$607,500 and \$810,000 in fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99, respectively.'
