COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 275, L.D. 339, Bill, "An Act to Establish Maine as a Sponsor of the Women in Military Service for America Memorial in Arlington National Cemetery"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "DEFENSE AND VETERANS' SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF" in that part relating to "Veterans' Services" by striking out all of the 2nd line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'All Other \$8,200'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

1997-98

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund \$8,200

This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$8,200 in fiscal year 1997-98 for the Department of Defense and Veterans' Services to provide funds for a grant to assist in the construction of the Women in Military Service for America Memorial in Arlington National Cemetery.'

This amendment raises the appropriation for the construction of the Women in Military Service for America Memorial in Arlington National Cemetery from \$5,000 to \$8,200. The \$8,200 represents the number of women veterans in the State, appropriating \$1 per woman veteran.
