Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

that area. This revenue loss may be partially offset by
additional sales. The amount of any additional sales can not be
estimated. This estimate assumes an August 1, 1998 effective
date. The annual revenue loss is estimated to be \$225,000.

6 The Legislature will require a General Fund appropriation of \$375 in fiscal year 1998-99 for the per diem and expenses of the 8 legislative member of a study commission established to explore the feasibility of locating a discount state liquor store in Fort 10 Kent.

12 Additional miscellaneous expenses of the study commission can be absorbed by the Department of Administrative and Financial 14 Services utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment establishes a study commission to explore the 20 feasibility and benefits of locating a discount state liquor store in Fort Kent. It also changes the title of the bill.

This amendment also adds an appropriation and a fiscal note 24 to the bill.
