HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to H.P. 277, L.D. 341, Bill, "An Act to Open a Discount State Liquor Store in Calais"

18 Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Open a Discount State Liquor Store in Calais and
Conduct a Study Concerning the Opening of a Store in Fort Kent'

24 Further amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Study commission established. The Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services shall establish a study 28 commission to explore the feasibility and benefits of locating a 30 discount state liquor store in Fort Kent. The study commission must include 2 business people from Fort Kent appointed by the 32 Director of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services; one Legislator appointed jointly by the President of 34 the Senate and the Speaker of the House; and 2 people appointed 36 by the commissioner. The member who is a Legislator is entitled to receive the legislative per diem as defined in the Maine 38 Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2 and reimbursement for travel and other necessary expenses for attendance at meetings of the 40 commission. Other members are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement of expenses. The meetings of the study commission must be held in Fort Kent. All appointments to the study 42 commission must be completed within 15 days after the effective 44 date of this Act. After the completion of all appointments, the commissioner shall convene the first meeting of the study 46 commission within 30 days after the effective date of this Act. The members of the study commission shall select a chair from 48 among the members. The study commission shall present its findings to the joint standing committee of the Legislature 50 having jurisdiction over legal and veterans affairs by January 1, 1999.
