Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4	Pt. B, $\S10$ and affected by $\S24$, is further amended to read:
6	2. Disabled veterans; special free license plates. The
Ü	Secretary of State on application and upon evidence of payment of
8	the excise tax required by Title 36, section 1482, shall issue a
U	registration certificate and set of special designating plates to
10	be used in lieu of regular registration plates to any 190%
	disabled veteran who is at least 50% disabled when that
12	application is accompanied by certification from the United
_	States Veterans Administration or any branch of the United States
14	Armed Forces as to the veteran's permanent disability and receipt
	of 100% at least 50% service-connected benefits. A disabled
16	placard is issued in addition to the disabled veteran
	registration plate at no fee.

	These special designating plates must bear the words "Disabled
20	Veteran," which indicate that the vehicle is owned by a disabled
	veteran.

26	Under current law a veteran must be 100% disabled in order
	to qualify for free disabled veteran registration plates.

	This bill reduces the required amount of disability to 50%
30	or more.
