28 30	F. The canning, processing, preserving, freezing, drying, marketing, storing, packing for shipment or distribution of:

pay requirements. These costs can be absorbed by the department utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

8 This amendment changes the original bill to exclude from the minimum wage provisions individuals employed by agricultural employers with 75 or more employees for 180 or more days per year. The amendment also requires that individuals employed at an egg processing facility with more than 300,000 laying birds be paid overtime. Finally, the amendment deletes from the original bill a provision that would have required all hours worked by an employee to be nonexempt from overtime pay requirements when the employee performs both exempt and nonexempt work within the same workweek.
