	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1747, as amended by PL 1993, c. 324, §1, is
4	further amended by adding a new paragraph at the end to read:
6	If a contractor is disqualified for any of the reasons
	stated in subsection 1, 2 or 4, the director may disallow the
8	contractor from bidding on any similar public improvement
	projects for a period not to exceed one year.

12	SUMMARY
14	This bill would allow the Director of the Bureau of Public Improvements to disqualify a general contractor from bidding or
16	public improvement projects for a period not to exceed one year.  Current law allows the director to disqualify a general
18	contractor on a project-specific basis only.
