HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 287, L.D. 351, Bill, "An Act to Decrease Infectious Disease Transmission"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 5 the following:

'Sec. 6. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§78 is enacted to read:

78. Hypodermic apparatus. Sales of hypodermic apparatuses.'

The additional sales tax exemption for hypodermic apparatuses will decrease General Fund revenue by \$11,250 in fiscal year 1997-98 and \$15,000 in fiscal year 1998-99. The corresponding decreases in dedicated revenue to the Local Government Fund for state-municipal revenue sharing will be \$605 and \$806, respectively.
