language from the description of coastal waters, prohibits the setting of nets outside of the fishing season and adds dip nets

This bill clarifies the definition and construction of elver fyke nets and the Sheldon eel traps. It removes redundant

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to the types of elver gear that are subject to the rebuttable assumption statute. Finally, it prohibits fishing the middle 1/3 portion of a stream at any state of the tide.
