to be submitted to the voters in November. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.

If approved by the voters, this resolution may have future cost implications during primary and general elections if a 2nd ballot is required to accommodate all of the elected officials due to the limited space on the ballots. The cost of adding a 2nd ballot is \$95,000.'

SUMMARY

14 This amendment deletes sections of the resolution proposing direct popular election of the Secretary of State and the 16 Treasurer of State. It also adds a fiscal note to the resolution.
