26	'Sec. 1. Demonstration project. The State Planning Office
28	shall establish and maintain, as a one-year demonstration project, a grant program to enable municipalities to study and
30	develop programs to deliver municipal services on a regional basis when such regionalization is likely to result in improved

34	1. Application for the grant must be made by 2 or more municipalities, one of which must be a service center community
36	as designated by the office in its 1996 report entitled "The Costs and Impacts of Development Patterns in Maine."
38	2. Application must be made on forms developed by the
40	office and must include at least the following information: the service being considered for regionalization; a summary of how

HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 297, L.D. 361

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3. Municipalities approved for grants shall fund at least 20% of the cost of the program to which the grant will be applied.

4. In awarding grants, the office shall seek to coordinate grants under this program with other grant and assistance programs offered by the office and shall give priority to communities designated as principal service center communities.

10 Sec. 2. Report. The State Planning Office shall submit a report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters no later 12 than December 1, 1999 regarding the demonstration project 14 conducted pursuant to section 1. The State Planning Office may as part of its report, proposed include, implementing 16 legislation. The committee may report out legislation based on those recommendations.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

FISCAL NOTE

38 This amendment reduces the General Fund appropriations required beginning in fiscal year 1999-2000 by limiting the grant 40 program to a one-year demonstration project.

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the bill, as amended by the committee amendment, and instead directs the State Planning Office to establish as a one-year demonstration project a grant program to assist municipalities in planning for regional service delivery to improve the quality or efficiency of municipal services.
