SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 300, L.D. 364, Bill, "An Act to Encourage the Use of Motor Vehicles That Use Alternative Sources of Fuel for the Purpose of Reducing Air Pollution"

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 14, 17 and 18.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment, which deletes the sales tax exemption for clean fuel vehicles and the income tax exemption for construction of service facilities for these vehicles, will eliminate the sales tax revenue reductions and the General Fund costs to the Bureau of Taxation.

SUMMARY

This amendment eliminates the sales tax exemption for clean fuel vehicles, the income tax exemption for construction of facilities to service clean fuel vehicles and reductions in the insurance premium tax.
