SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 303, L.D. 367

SUMMARY

Current law requires the operator of a motor vehicle to secure the operator and any passengers of that motor vehicle in seat belts. An operator may be cited for the failure of either the operator or a passenger to wear a seat belt. However, an operator is not required to pay a fine for failure to wear a seat belt unless the operator also is required to pay a fine for some other violation.

This amendment repeals the current requirement that the operator is required to pay a fine for some other violation than failure to wear a seat belt before the operator is subject to a fine for failure to wear a seat belt. A passenger 18 years of age or older is subject to a fine for failure to wear a seat belt regardless of the disposition of the violation by the operator.

This amendment also corrects a headnote to clarify the contents of the subsection.
