HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 304, L.D. 368, Bill, "An Act to Allow the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to Create Lifetime Fishing and Hunting Licenses"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§7161." in the 3rd indented paragraph from the end in the 3rd line from the end (page 2, line 21 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "limitations" the following: 'and prerequisites'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the holder of a resident lifetime fishing or hunting license must comply with all the limitations and prerequisites imposed on residents the same age who hold the equivalent annual license.
