COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 306, L.D. 370, Bill, "An Act to Establish a Commemorative Day Recognizing the Children of this State"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "\$134." in the first paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "September 28th" and inserting in its place the following: 'the last Friday in September'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The additional costs associated with designating a Children's Day can be absorbed by the Office of the Governor utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the date for the commemorative day for children from September 28th to the last Friday in September. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
