2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §134** is enacted to read:

6 **§134. Children's Day**

8 In recognition of the value and importance of every child,
10 the State designates September 28th as Children's Day. The
12 Governor shall annually issue a proclamation urging citizens,
14 businesses and organizations to observe the day with appropriate
16 celebration and activity.
