An Act to Consider Cost-effectiveness When Providing Medicaid Coverage for Dental Services.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 22 MRSA 3174-F, sub- $1, \P$ C and D, as amended by PL 1991, c. 591, Pt. P, 13, are further amended to read:

C. Extraction of teeth that are severely decayed and pose a serious threat of infection during a major surgical procedure of the cardiovascular system, the skeletal system or during radiation therapy for a malignant tumor; and

D. Treatment necessary to relieve pain, eliminate 12 infection, or prevent imminent tooth loss, and

Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §3174-F, sub-§1, ¶F is enacted to read:

 16 F. Other dental services, including full and partial dentures, medically necessary to correct or ameliorate an underlying medical condition, if the department determines that provision of those services will be cost-effective in
20 comparison to the provision of other covered medical services for the treatment of that condition.

SUMMARY

26 This bill requires that Medicaid coverage be provided for dental services, including full and partial dentures, when 28 medically necessary to correct or ameliorate an underlying medical condition and the coverage of these services is 30 cost-effective in comparison to other Medicaid-eligible medical services used to treat that condition.

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
