Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§14 is enacted to read:

14. Senior citizen public chance drawing. The department shall develop an annual special public chance drawing for residents 65 years of age and over to hunt moose beginning with the 1997 public chance drawing.

SUMMARY

This bill directs the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to develop a moose lottery system for senior citizens.
