Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7857, sub-§25, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 455, §43, is amended to read:

25. Prohibition on sales without lights. Except as
provided in this subsection, a person may not sell or offer to sell a new ATV unless that ATV is equipped with a functioning
headlight, -a and taillight and brake-light. This subsection does not apply to an ATV that:

A. Is a 2-wheel off-road motorcycle; or

B. Was manufactured prior to 1991. ; or

<u>C. Has an engine size of 90 cubic centimeters or less and has 4 or more wheels.</u>

18 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following: 20

'FISCAL NOTE

24 The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with 26 the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed in the court system. Reductions in the collection of fines may decrease 28 General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

SUMMARY

This amendment allows new all-terrain vehicles to be sold 34 without brake lights and allows the operation of all-terrain vehicles without brake lights during daylight hours. This 36 amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
