## **'FISCAL NOTE**

This bill may increase prosecutions for Class E crimes. If a jail sentence is imposed, the additional costs to the counties are estimated to be \$83.78 per day per prisoner. These costs are not reimbursed by the State. The number of prosecutions that may result in a jail sentence and the resulting costs to the county jail system are expected to be insignificant.

12 The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system 14 can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may increase 16 General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

## SUMMARY

This amendment amends a section of law relating to the 22 powers and duties of an election warden with regard to signature collectors to clarify that it relates only to the collection of 24 signatures not prohibited by law. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
