The George Cleeve Memorial Bridge. Resolved: That the new bridge spanning the Fore River between Portland and South Portland, which will replace the Million Dollar Bridge, be named the George Cleeve Memorial Bridge in honor of the man considered to be the founder of Portland, Maine and that a plaque be erected by the Department of Transportation near the bridge in commemoration of this premier settler.
