2 **Sec. 1. The George Cleeve Memorial Bridge. Resolved:** That the
3 new bridge spanning the Fore River between Portland and South
4 Portland, which will replace the Million Dollar Bridge, be named
5 the George Cleeve Memorial Bridge in honor of the man considered
6 to be the founder of Portland, Maine and that a plaque be erected
7 by the Department of Transportation near the bridge in
8 commemoration of this premier settler.

12 This resolve names the new bridge built crossing the Fore
13 River between Portland and South Portland in honor of George
14 Cleeve, who is considered to be the founder of Portland, Maine.
