An Act to Exclude from the Definition of "Employment" Services Provided by Lessees of Taxicabs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §1043, sub-§11, ¶F, as corrected by RR 1995, c. 4 2, §62, is further amended by amending subparagraphs 38 and 39 to read: 6 (38) Services performed by a person licensed as a 8 guide as required by Title 12, section 7311, as long as that employment is not subject to federal unemployment 10 tax; and (39) Services performed by a direct seller as defined 12 in 26 United States Code, Section 3508, Subsection (b), Paragraph (2). This subparagraph does not include a 14 person selling major improvements or renovations to the structure of a home, business or property .; and 16 18 Sec. 2. 26 MRSA §1043, sub-§11, ¶F, as corrected by RR 1995, c. 2, $\S62$, is further amended by adding a new subparagraph (40) to 20 read: 22 (40) Services performed by lessees of taxicabs. 24 **SUMMARY** 26 This bill excludes services performed by lessees of taxicabs 28 from coverage for unemployment tax purposes.
