

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 126, L.D. 405, Bill, "An Act to Create an Historic Preservation Tax Credit"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A by striking out all of the last line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'any combination of the 3;'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that a property owner may become a tax increment financing district to provide impetus for industrial development, commercial development, or rehabilitation of historic buildings or a combination of all 3.
