COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 127, L.D. 406, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Election Laws Pertaining to Absentee Ballots"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in the 15th line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "10" and inserting in its place the following: '5'

**SUMMARY**

The bill increases from 2 to 10 the number of absentee ballots that a 3rd person may hold at any time. This amendment changes the number from 10 to 5.
