26	FISCAL NOTE
28	The requirement that the life-cycle cost analysis currently
30	required for public school buildings be expanded beyond an analysis of energy issues represents a state mandate pursuant to
32	the Constitution of Maine. The additional local costs for engineering or architectural services is expected to be minor and
34	is expected to be offset by potentially substantial savings that will accrue over the life of the project as a direct result of
36	the analysis. General Fund appropriations will be required to fund at least 90% of the additional costs associated with the new
38	engineering or architectural services unless a Mandate Preamble is amended to the bill and 2/3 of the members of each House vote
40	to exempt this mandate from the funding requirement.'
