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SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P.
137, L.D. 416, Bill, "An Act to Regulate the Use of Personal
Watercraft"

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Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 11-A in the
3rd line from the end (page 1, line 47 in amendment) by striking
out the following: "and hovercraft" and inserting in its place
the following: '~~and hovercraft~~'

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Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 4
(page 2, lines 20 to 27 in amendment)

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Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering
any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read
consecutively.

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FISCAL NOTE

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This amendment eliminates the minor additional costs to the
Judicial Department and minor General Fund revenue increase from
filing fees associated with the new civil suits.

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SUMMARY

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This amendment deletes "hovercraft" from the definition of
personal watercraft. This amendment also deletes that section of
the committee amendment that authorized a person to bring a


