Вe	it	enacted	by	the	People	of the	State	of	Maine	as	follows:
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Sec. 1. 5 MRSA $\S20005$ -A, sub- $\S4$, \PD , as amended by PL 1995, c. 560, Pt. L, $\S6$ and affected by $\S16$, is repealed.

Sec. 2. Retroactivity. That section of this Act that repeals the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 20005-A, subsection 4, paragraph D applies retroactively to November 1, 1996.

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SUMMARY

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The purpose of this bill is to require the Commissioner of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services to services contracts for based on performance-based contracting. Under current law, the Commissioner of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services retains the right to reject any bids submitted or proposals made during negotiations in the course of a request for proposal procedure for state-funded alcohol or drug abuse programs. This bill eliminates the right of the commissioner to reject bids and specifies that the repeal applies retroactively to November 1, 1996.
