HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 144, L.D. 423, Bill, "An Act to Require That Headlights Be on during Inclement Weather"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 1 the 20 following:

'Sec. 2. Display of signs. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 23, chapter 21, the Department of Transportation is directed to erect signs on all state highways, as defined in Maine Revised Statutes, Title 23, section 351, informing motor vehicle operators that lights must be on whenever atmospheric conditions require continuous operation of the mechanical windshield wipers on the vehicles.

Sec. 3. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from the Highway Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
