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6 SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the resolve. It clarifies the intent of the resolve by allowing the Theta Chi Building
Association, which is currently a business corporation filed pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 13-A, to be changed to and recognized as a nonprofit corporation for all purposes under Title 13-B. The amendment retains the corporation's original filing date of August 15, 1907. This change takes effect retroactively to January 1, 1997. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
