An Act to Return Revenue from Lease Sites for Aquaculture to Municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6072, sub-§9, as amended by PL 1995, c. 502, 4 Pt. E, §38, is further amended to read:

6 Rents. After consulting with the Director of the Bureau 9. of Parks and Lands, the commissioner shall determine the rent 8 which--shall--be paid under each lease. The rent shall must represent a fair value based upon the use of and any structures in the leased area, but in no instance may the rental fee be set 10 at less than \$50 an acre. The commissioner shall--have--the discretion--to may increase the rental fees for categories of 12 leases. These changes may take effect over the term of a lease. 14The commissioner also may discount a portion of the rental fee during the first 2 years of operation of a new lease. This 16 discounted rate shall may not be less than \$50 an acre. A11 proceeds collected under this subsection must be transferred by the department to the municipality in which the leased site is 18 located.

SUMMARY

This bill establishes that the proceeds collected by the Department of Marine Resources from an aquaculture lease must be transferred to the municipality in which the leased site is located.
