24	Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

28	FISCAL NOTE
30	The estimated cost of sending this constitutional amendment out to referendum will vary according to the total number of
32	referenda enacted during the First Regular Session of the 118th Legislature to be submitted to the voters in November. The
34	estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an
36	additional \$7,000.
38	If approved by the voters, constitutional change may result in additional special sessions of the Legislature. The
40	Legislature will require additional General Fund appropriations for unbudgeted special sessions. The amount of the
42	appropriations that may be required can not be determined, but the costs of per diem and expenses for Legislators, for a 2-day
44	special session, are estimated to be \$67,680. Additional amounts will be required for session-only staff and other operating
46	costs.'
