SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 336, L.D. 458, Bill, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Change the Manner in Which the Legislature Calls Itself into Special Session"

Amend the bill in the 3rd indented paragraph after the title in the 8th line from the end (page 1, line 26 In L.D.) by striking out the following: "a majority" and inserting in its place the following: 'a-majority 2/3'

Further amend the bill in the question in the 3rd line (page 1, line 49 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "a majority vote" and inserting in its place the following: '2/3'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment requires a 2/3 vote of the membership of each House of the Legislature, rather than a majority vote, to call the Legislature into special session.
