COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 341, L.D. 463, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Ensure the Rights of Parents to Direct the Upbringing and Education of Their Children"

Amend the resolution by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

The estimated cost of sending this constitutional resolution out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the First Special Session of the 118th Legislature to be submitted to the voters in November. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.

If the constitutional resolution is approved by the voters, the effect of this constitutional amendment on the level of education spending can not be determined.'
