COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 342, L.D. 464, Bill, "An Act Regarding Potato Bin Pilers and Refund of Sales Tax"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Table with 3 columns: REVENUES, 1997-98, 1998-99. Rows include General Fund and Other Funds with corresponding revenue values.

The additional sales tax exemption for equipment used to transport potatoes from a truck into a storage location will decrease General Fund revenue by \$10,418 in fiscal year 1997-98 and \$17,252 in fiscal year 1998-99. The corresponding decreases in dedicated revenue to the Local Government Fund for state-municipal revenue sharing will be \$560 and \$1,003, respectively.

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
