Amend the bill by striking out all of the first paragraph after the enacting clause (page 1, lines 19 to 21 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997 to the department listed to carry out the purposes of this Act.'

This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$104,940 in fiscal year 1996-97 for the Department of Corrections to establish 9 new Guard positions at the Maine State Prison. Additional General Fund appropriations of approximately \$254,305 and \$278,842 will be required to fund these new positions in fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99, respectively. Funding for


