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

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

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**Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1310-F, sub-§1-B, ¶C,** as enacted by PL 1995,  
c. 665, Pt. HH, §1, is amended to read:

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C. The State's cost share is 0% for costs incurred for all work relating to landfill closure procedures after January 1, 1998 2000, unless the municipality and the department have agreed to an alternative closure schedule eligible for state cost share extending beyond January 1, 1998 2000, as specified in a consent agreement, department order or license, schedule of compliance or other agreement.

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**SUMMARY**

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This bill extends the date from January 1, 1998 to January 1, 2000 after which the State is not compensated for costs incurred for all work relating to landfill closure procedures.
