HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 359, L.D. 482, Bill, "An Act Regarding the Harvesting of Periwinkles in the Unorganized Townships"

Amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "§6811." by inserting after subsection 13 the following:

'14. Legislative body of unorganized township. For the purposes of this section, the county commissioners shall act as the legislative body of an unorganized township.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the county commissioners act as the legislative body for an unorganized township for the purposes of enacting an ordinance regulating the harvesting of periwinkles.
