Sec. 1. 9-B MRSA §241, sub-§11 is enacted to read:

11. Charges for verification of sufficient funds. A
financial institution authorized to do business in this State may
not assess a charge against a payee of a check for verification
of sufficient funds or a similar charge against a payee of a
check for the cost of verifying whether or not there are
sufficient funds to cover the amount of the check in the payor's
account with that financial institution.

## **SUMMARY**

16 This bill prohibits financial institutions from charging a fee to a payee of a check for verifying whether or not there are. 18 sufficient funds in the payor's account with that financial institution.
