COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 159, L.D. 488, Bill, "An Act to Change the Laws Pertaining to the Issuance of Copies of Birth, Marriage or Death Certificates by Towns"

Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph A in the 2nd line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "charge" the following: 'up to'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph A in the 2nd line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and \$3" and inserting in its place the following: 'and up to \$3'

SUMMARY

The amendment clarifies that a town clerk may charge an amount less than \$7 for the first copy of a birth, marriage or death certificate and an amount less than \$3 for each additional copy.
